A 24-hour hardware-focused integrated & embedded systems hackathon which has most recently had 250+ participants.


ShowOHI/O

Focus Events



Hack Al

A 2-day hackathon where students tackle projects with the help of artificial intelligence

Data I/O

A full-day workshop for ages 10 - 15 with Scratch, Python, Web Dev and real life applications of computer science.

Buckeye CTF

A hacking competition in which teams compete to obtain "flags" by solving security-based problems.

Bio-Hack


A healthcare-focused hackathon where students practice their teamwork skills, technical application, and innovative thinking.

	Mentors	Mentors get one-on-one interaction with teams while providing crucial project development support. This is a great way to build connections and meaningful engagement.
ENGAGEMENT	Judges	Judges help determine top performing teams and provide valuable feedback to students 100% online. This feedback empowers students to keep coding.




- Two \$2000 academic scholarships
